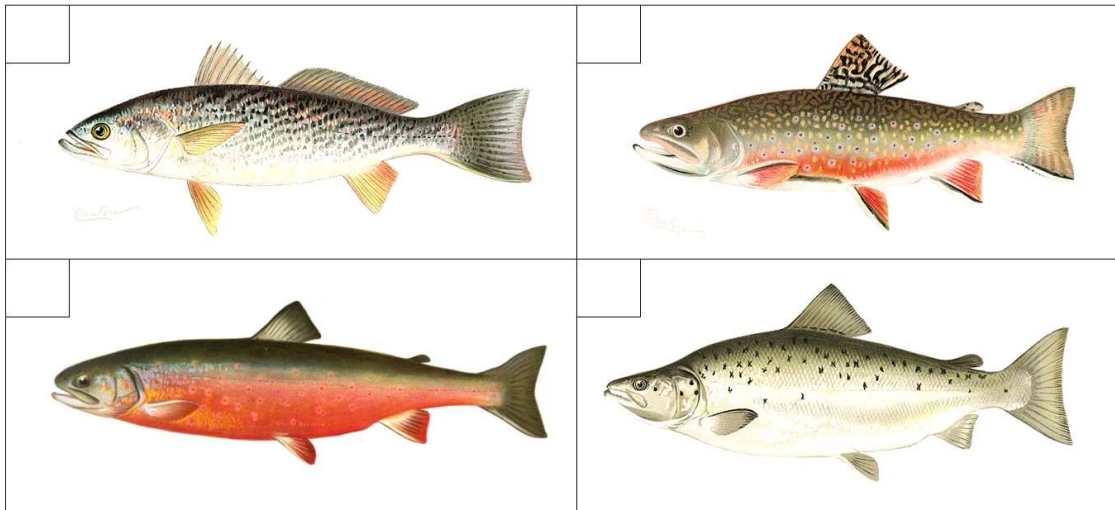

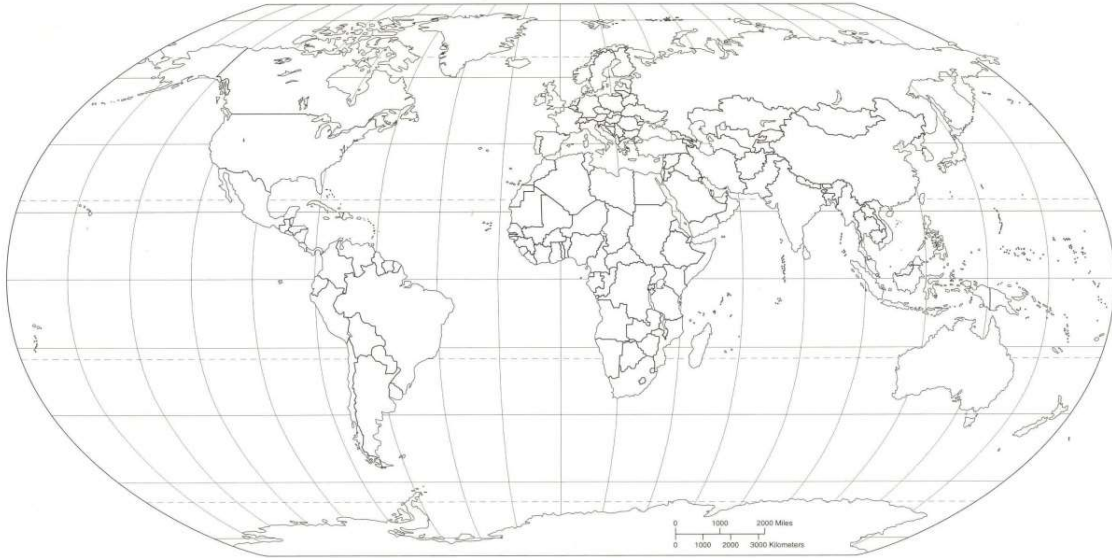

catadromous

„Birth” of birds and fish (plus many invertebrates) from eggs that their mothers have laid.

hatching

Breeding and conception outside the animal body, commonly found in species living in aquatic environments.

spawning

Hatch in freshwater, then migrate to the ocean and return to freshwater when it is time to spawn.

anadromous

Hatch in ocean, then migrate to freshwater and return to the ocean when it is time to spawn.
